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

29 High School Interns (McLain & Central)

EFS designed and implemented a customized internship training program.

91% (29/32) of scholars completed the course and **58%** of scholars reported an interest in STEM fields.



837 Total Lives Impacted (698 Scholars | 118 Families)

84% indicated improvement in math and science and **82%** in reading, **59%** of scholars indicated they plan to go to college, trade school, or military; and **58%** reported feeling more prepared for college and career.



Scholarships, College Tours & Enrichment Opportunities

45 scholarships awarded and 9 career exploratory opportunities beyond the classroom. EFS hosted 2 STEM Fairs and Essay writing competitions with 41 contestants.



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


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SUPPORT OUR YOUTH AND FAMILY RESILIENCE CENTER




